

**THE VALE OF GLAMORGAN COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND
LOADING AND PARKING PLACES)**

(CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) (AMENDMENT) (NO 3) ORDER 2022

1. On the 10th May 2022 The Vale of Glamorgan Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers made an Order to install and remove the Disabled Parking Place specified in the schedules below.
2. The Order will come into operation on 23rd May 2022 or on the dates that the signs and road markings are installed or removed whichever is the later and be known as the "Vale of Glamorgan Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Amendment) (No 3) Order 2022"
3. A copy of the Order and plans showing the affected area may be inspected on the Council's website at www.valeofglamorgan.gov.uk
4. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the above Act or on the grounds that any requirement of the same or that any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from the 23rd May 2022 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The following Traffic Regulation Order is to be amended as follows:

Vale of Glamorgan Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) Order 2013

SCHEDULE 1

Proposed Disabled Persons Parking Place

Barry Road, Barry (Ivanhoe) (AT52)

On the north side from the boundary line of the properties known as Ivanhoe and Elmore in a easterly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres.

Jewel Street, Barry (30) (AV53)

On the north west side from the boundary line of property numbers 30 and 32 in a north easterly direction for a distance of 5.1 metres.

Kingsland Crescent, Barry (AW52)

On the east side from a point 18.6 metres north of the junction with Dock View Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres.

Salisbury Road, Barry (43) (AX48)

On the north west side from the boundary line of property numbers 41 and 43 in a north easterly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

Victoria Road, Penarth (AM64)

On the north west side from the boundary line of property numbers 5 and 6 Denbigh Court, in a north easterly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres.

West Court, Penarth (6) (AK64)

On the south east side from the boundary line of property numbers 5 and 6 in a south westerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

Dochdwy Road, Llandough (26) (AH62)

On the north side from the boundary line of property numbers 26 and 28 in a westerly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

Proposed revocation of existing Limited Waiting Monday to Saturday 8am until 6pm 2 hours no return within 2 hours except Resident Permit Holders and replace with Disabled Persons Parking Place

High Street, Barry (61) (AX50)

On the northwest side from the boundary line of property numbers 60 and 61 in a north easterly direction for a distance of 5.1 metres.

Lombard Street, Barry (6) (AV51)

On the southwest side from the boundary line of property numbers 5 and 6 in a north westerly direction for a distance of 5.1 metres.

Arcot Street, Penarth (12) (AJ64)

On the east side from a point 5 metres south of the junction with Plassey Street, in a southerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

SCHEDULE 3

Proposed revocation of the existing Disabled Persons Parking Place

Castleland Street, Barry (74) (AW53)

On the south west side from the boundary line of property numbers 72 and 74 in a south easterly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

Station Street, Barry (64) (AW52)

On the north east side from the boundary line of property numbers 62 and 64 in a north westerly direction for a distance of 5.3 metres.

Queens Road, Penarth (95/96) (AI64)

On the north west side from a point 10 metres north east of the junction with Paget Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres.

SCHEDULE 4

Proposed revocation of the existing Disabled Persons Parking Place and replace with Resident Only Parking Monday-Saturday 8am-6.30pm

Maes Y Cym Street, Barry (59) (AU52)

On the north west side from the common boundary of property numbers 59 and 61 in a south westerly direction for a distance of 5.3 metres.

SCHEDULE 5

Proposed revocation of the existing Disabled Persons Parking Place and replace with Limited Waiting Monday-Saturday 8am-6.30pm 2 hours no return within 2 hours except permit holders.

George Street, Barry (23) (AV53)

On the north east side from the common boundary of property numbers 21 and 23 in a south easterly direction for a distance of 5.5 metres.

Lower Morel Street, Barry (28) (AV53)

On the north east side from a point 50 metres south east of its junction with Holton Road in a south easterly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres.

Woodlands Road, Barry (110) (AU52)

On the northwest side from the boundary line of property numbers 108 and 110 in a south westerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

Wyndham Street, Barry (30) (AU52)

On the north west side from the boundary line of property numbers 30 and 32 in a north easterly direction for a distance of 4.7 metres.
