

**THE VALE OF GLAMORGAN COUNCIL
(DRYDEN ROAD PENARTH)
(ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022**

1. On the 7th February 2023, The Vale of Glamorgan Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 & 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), section 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions Act 1976, and of all other enabling powers made an Order the general effect of which is as described in the Schedules below.
2. The Order will come into operation on the 13th February 2023 or on the dates the Traffic Signs and Road Markings are in place, whichever is the later and be known as the "Vale of Glamorgan Council (Dryden Road Penarth) (One Way Traffic) Order 2022".
3. A copy of the Order and plans showing the affected area may be inspected on the Council's website at www.valeofglamorgan.gov.uk
4. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the above Act or on the grounds that any requirement of the same or that any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from the 13th February 2023 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1

No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to proceed along the length of road described below, other than in a generally easterly then southerly direction, and as set out in the exemptions detailed in Schedule 2.

Dryden Road (Part), Penarth

From a point approximately 15.5 metres from its junction with Tennyson Road, in a generally easterly and southerly direction, to its junction with Wordsworth Avenue, a distance of approximately 235 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

Exemptions to the One-Way Order:

The removal of any obstruction of traffic.

Vehicles operated by Police, Fire, or Ambulances services.

Vehicles being used in connection with road sweeping, or gully cleansing operations.
