

**THE VALE OF GLAMORGAN COUNCIL
(OFF-STREET PARKING CHARGES)
(CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2022**

1. NOTICE is hereby given that the Vale of Glamorgan Council in exercise of its powers under sections 32,33 & 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers proposes to make an Order, the effect of which is to amend parking charges at the locations specified in the Schedule below.
2. These amended charges shall come into effect from **Monday 27th June 2022**

New Car Parking Charges

Rivermouth Car Park, Ogmore-by-Sea: 7am-11pm
(Charges apply 7 days per week; Monday to Sunday)

Location	Tariff
Rivermouth, Ogmore-by-Sea	0 - 1 hr = £1.00 1 - 2 hrs = £2.00 2 - 4 hrs = £4.00 All day = £6.00
Solo Motorcycles/Bicycles	Free

Blue Badge holders: are free but **must** apply for a FREE parking permit by contacting the Vale of Glamorgan Council on 01446 700111 Monday-Friday 9am-5pm or by emailing contactonevale@valeofglamorgan.gov.uk The permit can only be registered to ONE vehicle but extra permits are available to purchase as below. In the event that the free parking permit has been applied for but not issued, Blue Badge Holders can exit the car park by using the intercom at the barrier.

Parking permits: Are available to purchase for all coastal resort visitor car parks for durations of 6 months at £30 or 12 months at £50. (Financial Year 2022/2023) The permits are non-transferable and are car park and vehicle specific. Out of Hours Charge: Rivermouth car park will be open between 7am and 11pm. The bollard will only be operational to the public during these times. A penalty charge of £70 will apply to release a vehicle after the car park has closed. Payment will be requested in full before exiting the car park.

Coaches: Due to vehicle size restrictions within the entrance/exit of Rivermouth car park, coaches & vehicles larger than 7.7m in length & 2.43 m in width can no longer access this carpark.
