Please check your form and the details for accuracy.


If you can see names and nationalities of people at your address on the form and you want to add an elector or delete somebody that no longer lives at the property, you will need to do one of the following:

- Go online at www.registersecurely.com/VoG enter your unique security code which can be found on the A4 letter and make any amendments; or
- By telephone, please dial 0800 0608 799, enter your unique security code which can be found on the A4 letter and make any amendments.
- Complete the form and send back in the business reply envelope, which is addressed to Vale of Glamorgan Council.

Please note

The way to apply for postal votes has now changed. You can now choose to vote by post or proxy for either Reserved (General and Police and Crime Commissioner), Devolved (Senedd and Local) or all elections. You will need to provide a national insurance number for Reserved polls. By marking the canvass form with a yes or no for a postal or proxy we can send you a paper postal or proxy application. Or you can now complete a postal or proxy application online for Reserved (General and Police and Crime Commissioner) elections only by going to www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote or www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote. You will still need to complete a paper application for Devolved (Senedd and Local) elections.

We require you to respond to your CCB form by the deadline date of 11 September 2024.



If when you look at your form, there are no names of those who live at the property we advise you to:

o Go online at www.registersecurely.com/VoG enter your unique security code which can be found on the A4 letter and make any amendments.



If you have not responded after receiving the initial Canvass Communication PINK A4 letter by Wednesday 04 September 2024, you may receive an email reminder asking to promptly respond to the form. But you only receive an e-communication if we have your email address. If you do receive a Canvass e-communication and wish to opt out, please let us know.

After **Wednesday 11 September 2024** deadline, a **PINK** reminder letter will then be sent to any outstanding non responders. Anyone that has received a **PINK** reminder form and doesn't respond by **Thursday 17 October 2024**, may receive a telephone call and/or subsequent house to house visit.
