- Complete the form and send back in the business reply envelope, which is addressed to PO Box, Warrington.

We require you to respond to your CCB form by the deadline date of 23rd August 2021.

Should you not reply to your CCB form by 23rd August 2021 you will be sent a further A3 PINK known as the Canvass Communication Form (CCF) asking for the information again.

If you do not reply to either forms then we will contact you either by telephone, if we have these details, or we will send a canvasser to your property to ascertain the information.

Due to the current Covid-19 pandemic we will attempt to minimise knocking doors but as this is a legal requirement we may have to if no response is received.

Please remember that due to the changes in legislation 14–16-year-olds can now be added to the Register in readiness to vote when they turn 16. They will only be able to vote in some elections, not all elections.
