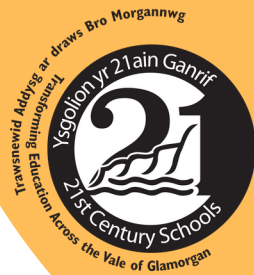

# 21st Century Schools



*TRANSFORMING EDUCATION  
ACROSS THE VALE OF GLAMORGAN*



The 21st Century Schools Programme is a long term strategic investment in educational estate throughout Wales.

It is a unique collaboration between Welsh Government, the Welsh Local Government Association (WLGA), local authorities, colleges and diocesan authorities.

More than £135 million is proposed to be invested in schools across the Vale of Glamorgan between April 2019 and March 2024.

## TRANSFORMING LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS...

- New schools are designed to meet BREEAM Excellent standard; which includes delivering energy efficient buildings, enhancing habitats for wildlife, and reducing the carbon cost of construction.
- Improved 21st Century learning spaces; including ICT facilities, specialist classrooms, and outdoor learning facilities.
- Flexible learning environments, enabling access for all and allowing teachers to focus on maximising educational outcomes.
- Ensuring an efficient supply and demand of school places across the Vale of Glamorgan.

## TRANSFORMING COMMUNITIES...

- Build programme utilises local supply chains, supports small businesses, and offers opportunities for new entrants to gain skills and experience through apprenticeships.
- Local community groups can apply for in-kind donations and volunteering time on projects to be delivered by the construction contractors.
- Pupils and the wider community able to access high quality green spaces, recreational and performance facilities, and meeting rooms.
- Lower maintenance costs and direct income opportunities for schools from hiring out facilities so more money can be put into learning.
- Programme promotes "STEM" (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) through school and curriculum engagement.
