Executive Summary:

To consider an application to approve an additional approved meter tester which will provide Hackney Carriage proprietors in the Vale of Glamorgan with greater choice of approved meter testers.

Recommendations

1. It is recommended that the application from DHM Taxi Meters is approved.

Reasons for Recommendations

1. To provide Hackney Carriage proprietors in the Vale of Glamorgan with a greater choice of approved meter testers.

1. Background

1.1 The Vale of Glamorgan Council's Conditions for Hackney Carriage states:

"The proprietor shall produce annually to the Licensing Authority a certificate issued by a meter installer approved by the Licensing Authority stating that the meter is accurate and contains only the current Vale of Glamorgan Hackney Carriage tariff."

- 1.2 There are currently four companies approved to issue Hackney Carriage meter certificates for vehicles licensed by the Vale of Glamorgan Council.
- 1.3 This matter has not been delegated to officers and is therefore a matter for the Public Protection Licensing Committee to determine.

2. Key Issues for Consideration

2.1 On 17 February 2025, the Council received an application from DHM Taxi Meters for approval from The Vale of Glamorgan Council to issue meter certificates for Hackney Carriages issued by the authority. The meters will be supplied by Viking Taximeters, Aquila Electronics and Digitax Electronics UK.

The application is detailed in Appendix A.

- 2.2 The applicant has advised that they use the A4226 for their measured mile; the distance between the traffic lights/crossing and the Porthkerry road sign. This proposed measured mile has been checked using two separate online mapping apps and is confirmed as correct.
- **2.3** A template of DHM Taxi Meter's Taximeter Certificate is detailed in Appendix B.
- 2.4 DHM Taxi Meters have supplied emails from Viking Taximeters and Aquila Electronics detailing that DHM Taximeters are authorised agents. These emails are detailed in Appendix C.
