Constituency Activity and Achievements

This year I have been extremely busy supporting residents in Dyfan with a wide range of problems. Homelessness, housing, consultation and education have been some of the most challenging issues, with land maintenance and fly tipping.

I helped organise some very successful events this year including a Family Fun day where around 700 people enjoyed live music and sunshine at Buttrills Community Centre. Secured funding for the Warmspace which running alongside the Foodbank has been continuing to support the most in need, but also building a strong sense of community by tackling loneliness and isolation. The POD and POBL advisors have attended each week solving a wide range of problems and creating opportunities for visitors.

It has been wonderful to welcome The Hive Guys Youth Club to Buttrills and to have been involved supporting them with their amazing projects including the mural they produced with Hurts So Good, engaging with older members of the community and building life skills. Thanks to the Vale Youth Service for their fantastic work.

I am honoured to work with dedicated community members who volunteer their time to help support others. Volunteers who have also successfully gained qualifications through their volunteering. It has been a privilege to be involved with CLT+ project and help volunteers with disabilities overcome challenges and gain skills, confidence and develop to look for further volunteer and paid roles.

It has also been great to work with Value in the Vale providing further opportunity to give back to our volunteers, and to make Buttrills CC a Period Dignity Collection Point.

White Farm Park now has a Community Orchard Project and a land management plan and interaction boards (hopefully more to come). Working with residents, LNP and Welsh Government to make a beautiful usable space to engage and bring the community together. We have gained skills and knowledge whilst doing so. I will keep helping this develop and support volunteers.

As promised, I successfully spoke at VOG planning to oppose the incinerator, this is something I will continue to pursue.
