# <u>REQUEST FOR THE USE OF EMERGENCY POWERS –</u> <u>CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC</u>

Re-purposing of schools to provide childcare. Establishment of childcare hubs and closure of non-hub school buildings. Provision of free school meals through a voucher system.

In response to Covid 19, Welsh Government took a decision to close all schools for educational purposes by 20<sup>th</sup> March. It was announced that schools in Wales would be repurposed from 23<sup>rd</sup> March to provide childcare for vulnerable children and the children of critical key workers.

All schools in the Vale of Glamorgan remained open for this purpose. However, it became apparent that this approach could not be sustained due to reduced staff capacity resulting from illness and self-isolation.

On 25 March, discussions commenced with Headteachers on the development of a hub childcare model. A new hub model will commence on Wednesday 1 April based in 14 schools across the Vale. The provision will be made available from 7am – 7pm, 7 days a week. It will also be offered during the Easter period including the bank holidays.

As a result of the social distancing requirements and restrictions to individual journeys, the current system of distributing free school meals has become unsustainable. A voucher system is being introduced from 1<sup>st</sup> April. Those eligible for free school meals will be sent 10 days supply of vouchers fortnightly. The daily value of the voucher is £3.90. The cost of provision over the Easter period is to be met by Welsh Government.
