<u>REQUEST FOR THE USE OF EMERGENCY POWERS –</u> <u>CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC</u>

SUBJECT: Proposal to temporarily end Ty Deri residential respite provision from August 2020

1. <u>Originating / Department / Service</u> – Learning and Skills: Additional Learning Needs & Well-being

2. Reason for Seeking Emergency Powers -

On 20 January 2020, Cabinet determined to consult on a proposal to temporarily end Ty Deri residential respite provision from August 2020 in order to meet increased demand for special education at Ysgol Y Deri. The consultation document was issues to stakeholders on 3 February 2020 and consultees were given until 13 March 2020 to respond.

The Council received two responses to the consultation; one response was in favour of the proposal and one response was against.

It is proposed that the proposal is implemented and residential respite provision at Ty Deri is temporarily ended from August 2020 to provide additional classroom space to accommodate increased pupil numbers anticipated at Ysgol Y Deri, the Council's special school.

A decision is sought using emergency powers to ensure that sufficient time is given to procure a contractor to undertake the building works to convert 4 rooms into teaching spaces. £120,000 has been included as part of the 2020/21 capital programme to increase the number of places available at Ty Deri.

On completion of the Ysgol Y Deri expansion, which in included as part of the Council's 21st Century Schools Programme, the need for respite provision can be re-assessed and, if a need is identified, the communal facilities could be reinstated at a relatively low cost and Ty Deri re-opened as a respite facility.
