The Council has been awarded a Welsh Government grant £424,700 in relation to work to update the Electoral Management Services in line with electoral reform in Wales.

The Purpose of the Funding is to reimburse the Council for the costs associated with the updated specification with the Electoral Management Services company Democracy Counts so their product complies with the electoral reforms introduced by the Senedd and Elections (Wales) Act 2000.

The Vale of Glamorgan Council is acting as the lead Authority for us and for Ceredigion County Council. A specific split of the grant between both Councils is not given in the award letter. The arrangement is for Democracy Counts to develop and upgrade the software which will be to the benefit of both Authorities. On this basis we are assuming a 50/50 split.

It is therefore requested to include a new scheme in the 20/21 Capital Programme of £212,350 to be funded from a Welsh Government grant.
