REQUEST FOR THE USE OF EMERGENCY POWERS – CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC

SUBJECT: Authority to submit Phase 2 Planning funding bid to the Welsh Government by 30th June 2020 to secure additional funding for homelessness and housing solution services

1. Originating / Department / Service -

Housing & Building Services – Housing Solutions and Supporting People Team

2. Reason for Seeking Emergency Powers –

In response to the COVID 19 pandemic, the Welsh Government issued guidance for local authorities on supporting rough sleepers https://gov.wales/coronavirus-covid-19-local-authority-support-for-rough-sleepers-html and outlined £10 million of funding available for Local Authorities to accommodate and support them https://gov.wales/written-statement-coronavirus-and-local-government. This was to ensure that people who were at risk of sleeping rough and those in inadequate temporary accommodation had access to the facilities that would enable them to adhere to public health guidelines on hygiene or isolation and mitigate their risk of infection.

Due to the Government directive to ensure that no-one should be without a home during the Covid 19 pandemic, the Housing Solutions Team have submitted Emergency Powers forms for permission to secure additional temporary accommodation to meet the increased demand to house applicants who would not normally be owed a statutory duty to be provided with temporary accommodation under the Housing (Wales) Act 2014.

Since the start of the pandemic, the Housing Solutions Team has assisted an additional 130 people into emergency B&B accommodation, with 61 currently in this accommodation and the numbers continuing to grow daily. Many of these people have struggled to engage with housing and support services in the past and are now benefitting from stable accommodation and intensive support. All clients in emergency and temporary accommodation are currently supported with floating support secured through the Supporting People Team. This support is largely provided over the phone however safe face to face visits are also being completed with a small number of the more vulnerable households.

On 3rd June 2020, the Welsh Government wrote to Local Authorities, setting out their vision for stage 2 of the pandemic response to homelessness, which expects Local Authorities to develop long term settled accommodation for everyone that has a housing need, ensuring that homelessness is rare, brief and non-repeated: https://gov.wales/continuing-support-homeless-people-

<u>during-coronavirus-pandemic-local-authority-guidance</u>. Local Authorities have been requested to develop a Phase 2 Plan, which will form the basis of a funding bid to new one off £20m funding including capital and revenue funding.

The attached briefing paper outlines our proposals for inclusion within our Phase 2 Plan.
