



Do Now task selection allows for completion independently			
Do Now is completed (answers included) within 5 minutes			
Do Now is relevant to the lesson.			
There is evident challenge (highlight in RED)

Coaching Bulletin

A reminder of the four non-negotiables for the Do Nows. There needs to be a Do Now at the beginning of every lesson, even if it is practical, coursework or revision.

1. Time

- The Do Now does not last longer than five minutes.
- Make this clear on your Do Now slide
- Use a timer

2. Task Focus

The Do Now must be relevant to the lesson. Either:

- A retrieval task linked to the previous lesson
- Work that is going to be covered during the lesson

3. Independent Task

The task should be independent

- Staff should not have to help pupils
- Pupils should not need to ask for help
- This allows staff to stand at the door and take the register

4. Challenge

There should be a challenge question in the Do Now

• This is not an extension activity, just a more challenging

Every teacher uses the same direct teaching approch

Every teacher coached 1-1 with lead practitioners

Every teacher has agreed to learning walks at any time

Outstanding teaching and learning team

Switching the conversation to teaching & learning

Over presence of SLT

- On duty
- On tour
