In the week leading up to the Women's Final, our Officers visited Camp Ninja; the Enothall Village in Bute Park: Champions Festival site at Cardiff Bay including the floating football pitch; and the Champions Village at Cardiff Castle. We worked closely with other members of the ELP including representatives from the Police. Police Licensing, Fire Service, Ambulance Service, Emergency Planning, Cardiff Events Team,

trading standards and Scensing who were out and about dealing with any potential problems. Fortunately, there were limited issues, but these included and inspection of mobile traders - one of which was problematic where cross contamination issues were identified, an inspection of a hot dog bicycle, and a public house which had opened despite being still under

Perhaps it was the city of Cardiff and not the football teams that really stole the show when the Champions League came to town - and we relished the challenge of keeping


