## 158 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST -

# 159 REAPPOINTMENT OF INDEPENDENT MEMBERS ON THE STANDARDS COMMITTEE (MO/HLDS) –

The purpose of the report was to seek approval for the re-appointment of three Independent Members on the Standards Committee.

Independent Members are Members who are not either a Councillor or an Officer of the Vale of Glamorgan Council or the spouse of a Councillor or an Officer of the Vale of Glamorgan Council or any other relevant Authority as defined by legislation, appointed in accordance with the procedure set out in the Standards Committees (Wales Regulations) 2001 (as amended) and the Standards Committees (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2006.

Independent Members are appointed for a period of not less than 4 and no more than 6 years in accordance with Regulation 18(i) of the Standards Committees (Wales Regulations) 2001 (as amended) as amended by Regulation 28a of the Local Government (Standards Committees Investigations, Dispensations and Referral) (Wales) Amendment Regulations 2016 and may be re-appointed for one further consecutive term not exceeding 4 years. Committee was also informed that Democratic Services had been advised that all three Independent Members were prepared to be re-appointed for a further consecutive term.

RESOLVED - T H A T the re-appointment of Mrs. P. Hallett and Mrs. L. Tinsley from 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 and Mr. R. Hendicott from 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2023 as Independent Members on the Standards Committee for the next four years be approved.

## Reason for decision

In compliance with the legislation and having received confirmation from the three Independent Members that they were prepared to be re-appointed for one further consecutive term not exceeding four years.

## 160 APPOINTMENT OF TOWN AND COMMUNITY COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE ON THE STANDARDS COMMITTEE -
